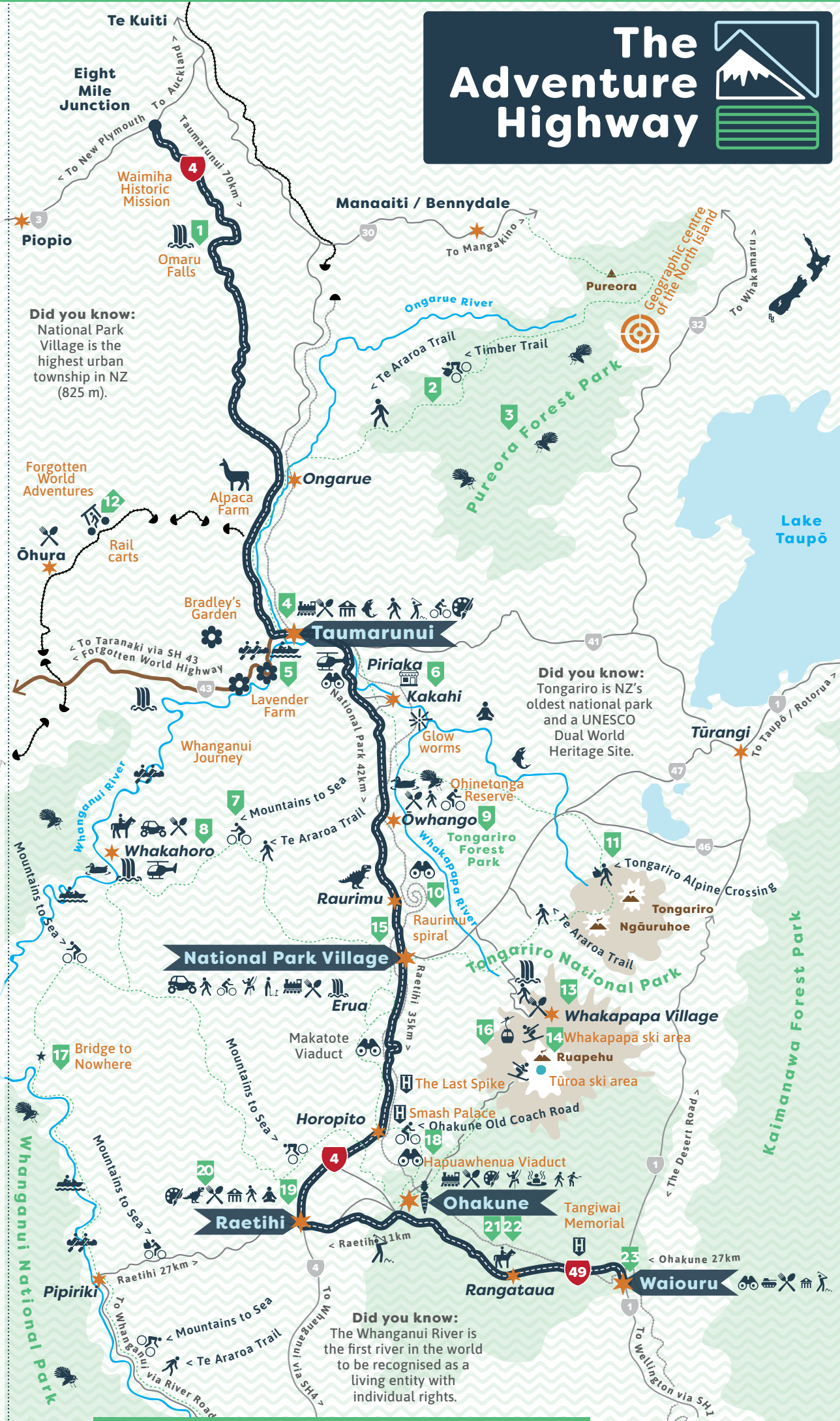

Choose your adventure:

Great riding adventures

Ruapehu is proudly home to two of the New Zealand Cycle Trails Great Rides with the Timber Trail and the Mountains to Sea - Ngā Ara Tūhono. So don't forget to bring your bike. Or hire one from one of our local operators.

Great walking (& paddling) adventures

The Adventure Highway connects with 2 of DOC's 'Great Walks' (one is actually a paddle down the Whanganui River) and there are heaps of really really good walks in the Ruapehu district.

National Park adventures

The Adventure Highway connects two National Parks. Whanganui and Tongariro. Breathe in that fresh national park air.

Alpine adventures

High altitude, volcanic landscapes, snow, skiing, Sky Waka.

Whanganui River adventures

Fly fishing, canoeing, kayaking, jetboating, camping, a living legal entity.

Rail adventures

Rail carts, railway heritage, marvellous engineering, the Raurimu Spiral, the Last Spike, railway museum, train stations galore.

Natural adventures

Pureora Forest, Whanganui National Park, Tongariro National Park, don't forget your Tiaki Promise.

Relaxing adventures

Exercise your taste buds, local markets, bush walks, hot tubs, hiking, biking, stargazing from your doorstep.
